1. Uninsured
2. A Johnston County resident
3. Between the ages of 6 months to 65
4. Experiencing a mild, non-emergent illness such as:

- allergies
- asthma
- cold/flu
- cough
- diarrhea
- diabetes
- ear problems
- female urinary problems
- fever
- mild headache/migraine
- mild stomachache
- high blood pressure
- pink eye
- rash
- sinusitis
- sore throat
